Issues that need to be resolved are matters such as a name for the new congregation, the election of a new single church council, the combining of the financial resources and the election of a chairperson and secretary of the new congregation, a new chairperson, secretary and treasurer of the church council.

Not everything can be resolved by the 3rd of December, and some patience will be required as our church councillors work through all the nitty-gritty details (such as bank accounts). But how exciting it is to have the opportunity under the guidance of God's Spirit to have this fresh start and renewed strength in mission!

# Welcome to the Rev. Lynden Broadstock

Today's supply preacher for Holy Communion at Hoppers Crossing/Crossroads UC congregations is Rev Lynden Broadstock (pictured).

Lynden is no stranger to members of Hoppers Crossing; he provided one year's supply ministry there in 2016.

He says: "My family were Salvation Army officers, involved in the Army's social work. I grew up at the Bayswater and Box Hill Boys' Homes, which were managed by my parents, and I attended Camberwell High School."

After completing an Economics Degree at Monash University, Lynden worked in the Commonwealth Public Service. He studied for the Uniting Church ministry at Ormond College in 1975-77. Ordained in 1977, Lynden's first parish was Camperdown. He then went on to a year's study at the University of Berkely Graduate Union, California USA. "That was a fantastic consortium of theological colleges," says Lynden.

He married Rose, a minister of the Uniting Church, and they ministered at Lilydale, (this writer was a parishioner at Lilydale UC in 1986 and was aware of Lynden's love of music in worship) Bairnsdale, Greensborough and Melton congregations. Rose worked as a Presbytery Minister in the Presbytery of Port Phillip West before her recent retirement. Lynden offered Supply Ministry for eight years until retiring in 2022.

They have three adult children, including daughter Bethany who has a role in the Uniting Church in Australia Assembly's Communications Unit, working on the Act2 program.

Now they are both retired, living in Melton South. Lynden says: "I enjoy listening to music, and I read a lot. I offer my greeting to the newly formed amalgamated congregation here in the City of Wyndham." (NT)
